**A MESSAGE FOR THE RESIDENTS OF  
FERRY ROAD, KETTERING**

This is to let you know that traffic queuing at Kettering for the Bruny Island ferry in peak periods at the start of the Queen's Birthday long weekend will face new traffic management measures.

In response to community concerns traffic marshals and police will be in attendance from Friday afternoon through until Saturday to ensure that traffic flows as smoothly as possible.

New permanent line-marking Keep Clear zones are in place to prohibit parking over residents' driveways on the bottom side of Ferry Road and police will be monitoring the situation to ensure motorists obey the rules.

There are already No Standing restrictions on the top side of Ferry Road.

All those queuing for the ferry will be urged to obey all signage and instructions from the traffic marshals and respect the rights of Ferry Road residents.

If these measures prove successful they will be put in place for other peak demand periods for travel to Bruny Island.

Quite apart from any other considerations, these measures are being introduced to ensure everyone's safety.
